


DIRECTIONS TO THE VEHICLE PROCESSING CENTER (VPC) FROM THE US NAVY BASE

Drive past Bennigan's on your right and you will come to a traffic light at the Grand Mosque. TURN LEFT onto the Al Fatih Highway. You will see signs for the Bahrain International Circuit - follow them. Proceed approximately 1.5 mile and BEAR RIGHT following the Bahrain International Circuit and Saudi Arabia signs. Continue approximately 0.8 mile and TAKE the FLYOVER TOWARD SITRA and cross the Sitra Causeway. DO NOT GO TOWARD SAUDI ARABIA.

After crossing the Sitra Causeway, you will see a Le Marche store on the right. Continue straight ahead and follow the Bahrain International Circuit signs. You will be on the Sh. Jaber Ah Ahmeed Al Subah Highway. Stay on this road, approximately 8.4 miles, until you get to the second roundabout. Exit the second roundabout at the nine o'clock position toward Askar. You will see nine smokestacks just past this roundabout.

After exiting this roundabout, take the first right. You will see the large sign of Gulf Union Automotive Repair. Go to the second road and turn left at the sign of Al Moshen Garage. The VPC is the last building on the left. You will need to ask the security guard for entrance to the area.

In-Transit Visibility (ITV) lets you check your POV shipping status. Enter your transportation Confirmation Number or your Shipping Instruction Number, then click Lookup.

Contact the VPC to update your phone number, so that VPC may contact you for POV updates. You will be notified by Personal Property Shipping Office to collect your POV from the VPC once the POV is cleared through Bahrain CUSTOMS.

When you arrive to pick up your vehicle you must present the following to the VPC personnel:

- ◆ Copy of Vehicle Inspection and Shipping Form.
- ◆ Copy of Orders - front and back to include any amendments
- ◆ Produce Military ID card to prove the ownership
- ◆ Temporary License Plates (Bahrain)
- ◆ Proof of Insurance

AUTO INSURANCE

Contact an insurance company of your choice to ensure that you have the required coverage for Bahrain. Local insurance companies will issue a card; that is the proof of insurance.

\$265-530 for insurance depending on vehicle value.

REGISTRATION

Registration of the Vehicle with Bahrain Traffic Directorate will be your responsibility. The following are required by the Traffic Directorate for registering your POV

- ◆ Vehicle (For Inspection)
- ◆ Customs Duty Free Certificate (Provided by the PPSO)
- ◆ Letter from the Personal Property Office certifying the status of the Title
- ◆ Proof of Insurance
- ◆ CPR Card of the owner
- ◆ Driver's License (Either Bahrain Or Stateside)
- ◆ Notify VPC if you choose an agent to pick the POV
- ◆ Registration Fees \$97 (Directorate of Traffic)
- ◆ Temporary plates and handling fee: \$40-80

CLAIMS PROCESS

A joint inspection of your vehicle will be performed and if any new damages are found you must annotate this on the reverse side of the Vehicle Inspection and Shipping Form.

If any items shipped with the vehicle are missing, this must also be annotated at this time. You will be provided with a copy of the International Auto Logistics (IAL) Claims Filing Instructions which clearly outlines your options for filing a claim.

There are four different options for filing a claim:

- ◆ Site Settlement
- ◆ IAL Claims
- ◆ Military Claims
- ◆ Inconvenience Claims

Each offers a different level of service and convenience
