



Dear Newest Eielson AFB Member,

As the Goldrush Inn Lodging Manager, allow me to be one of the first to congratulate you on your assignment to Eielson AFB, home of RED FLAG Alaska.

PCS moves can be challenging and hectic and the last thing travelers need to worry about is temporary living arrangements upon arrival to their new base.

Whether traveling unaccompanied or with family members, the time to secure lodging at Eielson is the moment PCS orders are issued. **DO NOT procrastinate.**

If arriving between 1 May and 30 September and you require a Temporary Lodging Facility (TLF), please call us immediately as there is normally zero availability for TLFs during this period. Otherwise, chances of you and your family living in a downtown hotel upon arrival increase every day you delay in contacting us. PCS member's initial stay in Lodging is up to 30 days. Extensions beyond 30 days are granted solely on availability at the end of the initial reservation.

If you are bringing pets, be advised that we have a limited number of Pet Friendly TLFs. In the event that Pet TLFs are not available upon your arrival, Lodging will work to house you and your family in a non-pet TLF, but you will have to kennel your pet's off-base. **BE PREPARED for this possibility.** Local kennel information is available upon request.

NOTE: Letters of Non-Availability WILL NOT be issued due to the unavailability of Pet TLFs.

Pet owners MUST provide current pet records upon check-in. If pet records are not provided upon check-in, your stay will be limited to 24 hours.
