The Department of Defense and Sesame Workshop collaboration began in 2006, when both organizations agreed that military children of preschool age would benefit from a resource to help them cope with the experience of a deployed parent. The result of this collaboration was the much-needed support and practical education captured by “Talk, Listen, Connect.” The initiative features videos, storybooks and workbooks, specially created for this program, that guide families through tough transitions.
