## Interactive Online Survivor Benefits Reports

## Background

To honor those who died while serving our nation, the Defense Department commits to doing all it can to support the surviving families of service members. The casualty assistance officer will provide an initial survivor benefits report to eligible surviving spouses, dependent children and their guardians. To improve this continued level of support for surviving family members, the DOD has interactive online survivor benefits reports that provide current and estimated future benefits.

## **Highlights**

The interactive online survivor benefits reports:

- Are available for eligible survivors of service members who have died on active duty.
- Are accessible 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.
- Display current and estimated future benefits and allow survivors to input "what if"-type changes to family members' education, disability and marital status and save and print reports.
