Spouse Ambassador Network

Background

The Spouse Education and Career Opportunities program launched the Spouse Ambassador Network in July 2013. The Spouse Ambassador Network was developed by military spouses, for military spouses and is made up of Military Spouse Employment Partnership organizations who share common goals with the Department of Defense in raising awareness about challenges related to military spouse employment and increasing career opportunities that facilitate the mobile military life. It is a collection of organizations within MSEP who have established community networks and want to leverage those networks to broaden knowledge about military spouse employment resources. The Department of Defense is seeking to connect these existing networks and local businesses, community organizations and local chambers of commerce to educate, empower and mentor military spouses.

Highlights

- The mission of the Spouse Ambassador Network is to educate, empower and mentor military spouses to encourage career fulfillment by promoting and sharing resources while facilitating effective relationships with local and national stakeholders.
- The Spouse Ambassador Network will allow partner organizations to connect with like-minded partners in local communities and with military spouses where they reside.
- Through the Spouse Ambassador Network, DoD will provide support to MSEP partners' on-going efforts by providing materials and resources meaningful to military spouse employment.
- On July 16, 2013, the U.S. Chamber Foundation plans to co-host a roundtable with Spouse Education and Career Opportunities to bring together a core group of MSEP partners to discuss the tools of the Spouse Ambassador Network and share existing avenues of support.
