Background

Military OneSource was created in response to the need for a centralized assistance program to support military members and their families with meaningful, relevant information and services. No cost support is available online and by telephone. The website and call center deliver comprehensive resources and information of interest to the military community, as well as access to coaches, counselors and consultants who can provide expert, solution-focused assistance.

Highlights

Military OneSource is available to active duty, National Guard and reserve service members, their families and survivors to help solve problems and connect with their communities. Program highlights include the following:

- The Military OneSource website serves as a gateway to information and support in the form of articles, podcasts, webinars, monthly electronic newsletters and links to official resources.
- Confidential non-medical counseling can help service members, their families and survivors address challenges and overcome personal concerns. Counseling is available face-to-face in the local community, by telephone, secure online chat or video format.
- Service members, their families and survivors can receive specialty consultations 24/7/365 on issues related to adoption, adult disability, education, elder care, health and wellness, special needs, spouse relocation and transition, peer-to-peer and wounded warrior.
- The Spouse Education and Career Opportunities program assists military spouses with targeted career information, resources and access to certified career counselors.
