Through its partnerships, MWR also makes other summer recreational opportunities affordable for military families:

- Blue Star Museums expands Morale, Welfare and Recreation opportunities by offering admission at no cost for military personnel and their families to participating museums from Memorial Day to Labor Day.
- The Department of the Interior, in partnership with the Department of Defense, created the “America the Beautiful” Military Pass Program, providing access at no cost to more than 2,000 federal recreation sites, including all national parks and national wildlife refuges, national forests and grasslands, and on lands managed by the Bureau of Land Management and Bureau of Reclamation.
