## Spouse Ambassador Network

### Background

The Spouse Ambassador Network is a new initiative through the Department of Defense Spouse Education and Career Opportunities program designed to create opportunities to leverage existing networks of support for military spouses. The foundation of the Spouse Ambassador Network is formed by Military Spouse Employment Partnership partners. Organizations that are a part of the partnership share common goals with the Department of Defense in raising awareness about challenges related to military spouse employment and increasing career opportunities that facilitate the mobile military life. The Spouse Ambassador Network offers the opportunity for MSEP partners to broaden their commitment by sharing Spouse Education and Career Opportunities program information and resources with military spouses and community leaders.

### Highlights

- The mission of the Spouse Ambassador Network is to educate, empower and mentor military spouses to encourage career fulfillment by promoting and sharing resources while facilitating effective relationships with local and national stakeholders.
- The Spouse Ambassador Network will allow partner organizations to connect with like-minded partners in local communities and with military spouses where they reside.
