



The Military Spouse Employment Partnership Career Portal: Your Key to Job Search Success

After registering for an account on the MSEP Career Portal, you are ready to jump-start your job search. Learn how to start searching for jobs by following the tips below.

How to search for jobs

The MSEP Career Portal job search allows you to look for positions based on job title and location. Click "Search" to populate your results. You'll then be able to sort your results by the following categories:

- Company
- Job title
- Location
- Date posted

For example, to look for a teaching position, you might enter "Teacher" under job title; limit the search further by entering your location. After clicking "Search," your results will appear below. For best results, begin your search with broad terms and then narrow to more specific terms.

You can use the MSEP Career Portal's "Advanced Search" feature to look for openings by company, industry and job type. You can also limit your search to a specific mile radius from your ZIP code.

If you are interested in finding a nursing position, you might use the "drop-down" menu under "Company" to browse through the list, looking for companies in the healthcare sector. Alternatively, you could use the "drop-down" menu under "Industry" and select "Healthcare."

To find more information about a specific job posting, simply click on "Learn More" or the job title. You will land on a page where you can read the full job posting. If you are interested in applying, click on "Go to Job," and you'll be directed to the employer's website, where you can submit your application.
