The Military Spouse Career Advancement Accounts Scholarship (known as MyCAA) has already helped thousands of eligible military spouses find and fund the education and training they need to pursue high demand portable careers. If you're an accredited, military-friendly school with robust, proven career-oriented student services and programs of study, we want YOU to be a part of MyCAA!

The MyCAA Scholarship is sponsored by the Department of Defense.

What does it take to be a MyCAA school?

- ✓ **Be accredited** – Department of Education, a state board or a DoD-approved industry regulating body is acceptable.
- ✓ **Offer portability** – School's education and/or training programs will provide MyCAA spouses with a certificate or associates degree (excluding general studies and liberal arts) which help spouses obtain careers that will move with them.
- ✓ **Support your students** – School must extend the Servicemembers Opportunity Colleges Military Student Bill of Rights to MyCAA spouses.
