When orders come to relocate, military spouses often have to give up their current job. It can be challenging to find work right away because of a different job market, a busy schedule or licensing issues. But that doesn't mean your family has to suffer financially!

From Alaska to Florida, 45 states and the District of Columbia now allow military spouses, who leave employment because of a military move, to apply for unemployment compensation. Your financial stability is critical to your family's well-being, so find out if you can apply for compensation in your current state.
