## 1 Up-to-date News and Information

Stay on top of all the latest news related to a particular program! Each program page offers The Latest section on the top right hand side to track the latest facts, policy changes, and important information. In addition, a schedule of upcoming webinars on relevant topics is posted to give service providers an easy way to know what's being offered to website users.

## 2 Simple Navigation and Organization

Each program page offers an overview of the program, important policy and legislative information, popular links, a featured program-related blog, and tools and resources designed to make finding information easy and efficient. Along the top, service providers can always access the main toolbar for one-click access to other important parts of the site.

## 3 Additional Features

Policy and programmatic information previously available through MilitaryHOMEFRONT is now available on the service provider landing pages for each topic.

The right hand side of the page offers additional features to increase the amount of interaction users have with the page.

The Directory allows users to quickly access program-specific contact information for their installation. The contact information is pulled from the MilitaryINSTALLATIONS website and appears within the Directory on Military OneSource. In addition, users can select "advanced search" and link to the MilitaryINSTALLATIONS homepage, where they can further refine their search requirements.

Users can also subscribe to Really Simple Syndication (RSS) feeds to ensure they are alerted whenever changes are made to the program page. In addition, there is one-click access to resources and tools designed for families or leaders.
