GRANDMOTHER'S TRUNK

This game can be played with two or more players. The first player begins the game by saying,

"I put _____ in grandmother's trunk," and fills the blank with the name

of something he or she wants to pack. The second player repeats what the first player has put in the trunk, and then adds an item. For example, the first player might say, "I put a doll in grandmother's trunk." The second player would say, "I put a doll and a stinky shoe in grandmother's trunk." The game continues with each player repeating the previous item until a player forgets an item or changes the order. That player is out of the game, and the next player starts over. The last player remaining wins.



20 QUESTIONS

This classic game of "Who am I?" can be played with two or more players. The first player thinks of a person - a celebrity, a family member or a TV character, for example. The other players take turns asking yes or no questions for clues to the identity of the person. The first player who guesses correctly wins the game and gets to choose a new identity in the next round.



I SPY

This game can be played with two or more players. The first player finds an object to spy on the road or inside the car and says, **"I spy something,"** filling in the blank with the color of the object. The other players take turns guessing what the object is. The first player to correctly guess wins the game and gets to spy an object in the next round.
