2010 Results

The 2010 Military Family Life Project is a survey that measured the attitudes and opinions of active duty spouses. The results from this survey will help shape how the military provides programs for spouses and families. Some of the focuses of this survey were spouse employment, education, and financial health. There was a follow up survey in 2011 and results will be released soon.

41% of active duty spouses reported concern about their financial condition (e.g., tough to make ends meet or were in over their heads)
