Thanks for your inquiry about your upcoming move to your new installation. Please note that you should use www.militaryinstallations.dod.mil as it will be very informative for both you (and your spouse).

General Instructions for the Website:

On the first page of this website, click on "**View a Directory of Installations**" to select your new installation by service or type in **the name of your new installation** on the top line and select it by clicking on the drop down box that comes up. Then click the "**Go**" button to the right of that line. That will bring you to information about your new installation and more information about your move.

Notice that along the top of the installation page, there are several tabs to select from:

Installation Overview allows you to see a specific overview of the installation in general

Installation Contacts will give you information from your new post guide along with links to those identified individuals

Photo's allows you to view pictures of your new installation

Major Units gives you information about the units on that installation along with phone numbers for you to connect with them

Local Community Information gives you a cost comparison between where you live and your gaining duty installation

Plan My Move will help you plan a specific calendar of things that you should do each day to ensure that your move goes smoothly.

Request a Sponsor allows you to request a Sponsor on-line to assist you with your move to your new installation and home.

Additionally, on the right hand side of your screen, you will see more information with drop down screen's. Click on any of the "+" signs and it will give you more information about those subjects. For example:

Housing will give you more information under the "Automated Housing Referral Network" (www.ahrn.com) for housing off post. You should contact the Housing Office on your gaining duty installation to get on their list first, as that is a requirement to let them know you are coming. They will also have more information about rentals and certain areas to stay away from. You can book temporary housing from the **Dod Lodging** link with any service, anywhere in the world.

Household Goods will give you information about scheduling your move. You can click on **Move.mil** (www.move.mil) to schedule your move on-line. You can also get more information about shipping or storing your vehicles, managing a government move and doing a **DITY** move.

Financial Planning will give you information about knowing your allowances, determining your housing options along with giving you a link to set up your travel.

Notice that each item that is underlined throughout this website is a direct link to more information that will be useful in completing your move successfully. Also, if you are wondering about the time difference and the weather in that area, it is captioned in real time each time you open this program on the bottom right side of the screen.

States

View articles and local and state directories for additional information about the state you are going to. You can also use this as a tool if you are going to an area where there isn't an installation in close proximity to where you are going.
