

How to Find a Room in the Pentagon

The Pentagon is comprised of five concentric rings which are connected by ten spoke-like corridors.

- **The first number or letter indicates the floor for which the room is located:
B=Basement, M=Mezzanine, 1-5= Floors.**
- **The letter indicates the ring for which the room is located :
A,B,C,D and E for the Mezzanine or F and G in the basement only.**
- **The next digit or two digits indicate the corridor the room is located:
Corridors are designated 1-10**
- **The last two digits indicate the specific bay or room number for an office:**
 - **EXAMPLE, to locate room 3D126**
 1. Go to the third floor, A ring
 2. Proceed along the A ring to the 1st corridor
 3. Go down the 1st corridor to the D ring
 4. Turn left and proceed to room or bay number 26

Entering the Pentagon

A Pentagon Access Badge is required for entry into the Pentagon.

- **To gain access to the building:**
You will need to go to the Visitor Control Desk located at the Metro Entrance and present your CAC plus a local, federal or state issued photo ID to receive a visitor badge.
- **To obtain a Pentagon Badge:**
Contact your agency's Authorizing Official (AO) or security manager for a DD Form 2249, "DoD Building Pass Application." This a controlled form only available through the AO or security manager.
