Mission

Spangdahlem VTF is professionally staffed by Army Veterinary Corp and NAF personnel with the primary mission of providing complete veterinary care for all government owned animals.

Access

Privately owned animals of eligible military medical beneficiaries are authorized to receive veterinary care on a space available basis. The following categories of personnel are authorized to receive veterinary care for their privately owned animals:

- a. Members of the Uniform Services on active duty and their family members.
- b. Retired members of the Uniform Services and their family members.
- c. Members of the Reserve Component who have been called to active duty and their family members.
- d. U.S. citizens stationed outside the United States who are employees of the DOD or other Federal agencies paid from appropriated funds or nonappropriated funds and their family members. Please call to make an appointment.

Services

Our clinic provides routine preventive medical care (vaccination, deworming, examinations, etc.), sick call examination, wellness programs, health certificates, elective surgical procedures, and dental prophylactic cleaning during clinic hours. We have in-house laboratory procedures (blood work, urinalysis etc.) and x-ray capabilities. We do not have hospitalization capability.

Emergency Care:

Emergencies are not seen at this time. Pets requiring care beyond the capabilities of our clinic or after duty hours will be referred to a US or host nation veterinarian.

SPANGDAHLEM AIR BASE INSTRUCTION 48-102

Base order states that all pets must be registered at our veterinary clinic within two weeks of arrival or acquisition of pet. Every pet must be ISO microchipped and have a valid rabies vaccine. Be a responsible owner. Don't abandon your pet.
