



## SPEEDING IN GERMANY

The following chart gives you an idea, what kind of monetary fine to expect for speeding off-base:

KM/H	21 – 25	26 - 30	31 - 40	41 - 50	51 - 60	61 - 70	over 70

## FAILURE TO KEEP SUFFICIENT DISTANCE FROM PRECEDING VEHICLE

Distance less than .../10 of half of the speedometer	Speed 80 – 100 km	Speed 100 – 130km	Speed over 130 km
5/10	75 €	75 €	100 €
4/10	100 €	100 €	180 €
3/10	160 €	160 € <b>(1 month suspension)</b>	240 € <b>(1 month suspension)</b>
2/10	240 €	240 € <b>(2 month suspension)</b>	320 € <b>(2 month suspension)</b>
1/10	320 €	320 € <b>(3 month suspension)</b>	400 € <b>(3 month suspension)</b>

The above amounts do not include fees for the case. You have to add another 25 - 30 € for the proceedings.

This is ruled in the German Road Traffic Ordinance (STVO)
