Survivor Outreach Services

Mission: To build a unified program which embraces and reassures Families of our Fallen Warriors that they are continually linked to the Armed Forces Family for as long as they desire. The role of the SOS coordinator can be summarized as the person responsible for outreach, assessment, referrals, and advocate in general raising a red flag when gaps appear.

Services Provided

- Supportive grief counseling
- Life Skills Education: SOUTHCOM training on topics such as stress management, anger management, communication skills, parenting, grief.
- Legal advice: probates, wills, notary public services, legal advice, etc
- Financial Advice: College planning instruction, referrals, education on financial instruments, education planning, counsel for adverse monetary behaviors, personal finance, money, benefits, and/or insurance, budgeting, scam prevention, Retirement counseling, credit/debit counseling, Army Emergency Relief, consumer advocacy,
- Employment counseling: how to write a resume, interview skills, etc (not to be confused for a job agency)
- Family Advocacy: where to go, what to do, supportive counseling
- Relocation advice, estate counseling: sales, rentals, foreclosures, interpreting contracts, etc
- Child and Youth programming: counseling, free respite care, childcare advice, New Parent Support Program, School Liaison Services, playgroups, surviving child activities, Grief Camps
- DEERS

- TRICARE
- Entrance vehicle decal
- Immigration
- Knowledge of other supportive organizations
- Other: The Survivors are basically encouraged to come to us with any kind of problem. We've had inquiries on transportation of household goods from the Deceased Service Member, recovery of old military records, or replacement of lost ID Tags.
