On behalf of the 81TRW/CC, I welcome you to Keesler AFB and the beautiful Gulf Coast of Mississippi. The School Liaison Officer serves as the liaison between the installation commander, base agencies, military parents, and schools by providing assistance in matters pertaining to student education. The School Liaison Officer specializes in serving military families and offers a wide spectrum of services, enabling families to become more involved in their child's educational experience. Services include: supporting families with inbound/outbound school transfers, providing information on local schools and boundaries, assisting with school choice, helping families understand the special education process, making military and community agency referrals, and supporting families with the home schooling process.

School Guide:

This guide contains valuable information on our local public schools, private/parochial schools, and home schools. As your SLO, I remain neutral and strongly support all of our school districts. The data and information provided comes from web pages listed in this guide, and is available to the public. There are approximately 3,500 DOD children attending school along the Mississippi Gulf Coast.

Age Requirements:

Students entering Kindergarten must be 5 on or before Sept 1, 2014.

Students entering first grade must be 6 on or before Sept 1, 2014.

*Kindergarten is not a mandatory requirement in Mississippi.

Registration Requirements for New Students:

Mississippi Certificate of Immunization Compliance Form 121 (KAFB Med Ctr, Health Dept, etc)
Certified copy of birth certificate (not a hospital certificate)
Report cards and /or other records of grade placement
Student's Social Security Number
Verification of Residency (must provide 2 forms of proper documentation: utility bills, driver's license listing present address, automobile registration, filed Homestead Exemption application form, mortgage documents or property deed, apartment or home lease, or base housing lease.)
GUARDIANSHIP: Legal guardian must provide a copy of the most recent court order, signed by a judge, appointing them as legal guardian.

HB 879-Allows military parents residing on base school district choice:

Effective 1 July 2013 parents residing on Keesler AFB have the option of enrolling their children in adjacent school districts (Gulfport, Harrison County, Jackson County, and Ocean Springs). Parents must provide copy of base housing lease agreement along with required registration paperwork. Parents must provide transportation to out-of-district school of choice.

Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children:

In 2009, the Military Interstate Compact was signed into Mississippi law. The Compact provides for uniform treatment of military children transferring between school districts and states. The Compact has specific articles that deal with: enrollment, immunizations, placement, graduation, and many other areas of importance. Residency & Enrollment:

It is very important that you understand the importance of home residency and school enrollment. Where you live MAY determine where your child will attend school. While several of our districts allow for outside transfers, some do not. There may also be a tuition fee associated with outside transfers. Transferring your child involves an approval process from the losing and gaining schools. In addition, you must provide transportation to the out-of-district school. Transfer information is provided under each individual school district below.

Special Education:

Special Education (SPED) is a complex, emotional subject. Communication is the key when dealing with school districts and SPED. I recommend to our parents to become familiar with federal and state law. Federal law information can be found at www.wrightslaw.com and MS state law at www.mde.k12.ms.us/special-education/special-education-policies-and-procedures . Information ranging from initial evaluations to mediation can be found here. I am available to assist and prepare parents with their SPED objectives.

Home School Information

Home school students must register by 15 Sept each school year, but parents can transfer children to home school at any time during year.

To register, contact the school attendance officer assigned to the public school that you would have been attending. You are required to fill out a Certificate of Enrollment for each child that will be home schooled. 

QDI:

A Quality of Distribution Index (QDI) value is calculated using data from the MCT2 language arts and mathematics tests; SATP data from the Algebra I, Biology I, English II, and U.S. History tests; and results from the language arts and mathematics sections of the MAAECF.

QDI (Quality of Distribution Index) represents an overall measure of student performance on statewide assessments during the previous school year.
