SUBJECT: Unaccompanied Personnel Weight Restrictions and Housing Policies.

1. All unaccompanied personnel PCSing to Kadena AB, Okinawa, Japan are weight restricted. Unaccompanied personnel are not authorized a House Hold Goods shipment (HHG). Unaccompanied personnel are only authorized one of the following entitlements; unaccompanied baggage shipment or 10% of full JFTR, see charts below for weight allowances.

O-6	500 lbs.	1800 lbs.

2. Unaccompanied E-5 and below are not authorized to reside off base. They must live on base in unaccompanied dormitories. Unaccompanied personnel should fax or e-mail a copy of their orders to his/her sponsor so a room can be reserved prior to arrival to Kadena.

3. Unaccompanied E-5 and below are not authorized to ship pets. The only pets authorized in unaccompanied dormitories are fish. All unaccompanied E-6 and above please check rules, regulations and your local TMO prior to shipping pets.
