

Many Family support programs will be available to visit, Army Community Service Family Support Programs, Morale, Welfare and Recreation, Chaplains, Community Chambers, Education Center, and many more who are here to support the Soldiers and their Families.

All Soldiers are required to in-process through Kalsu Replacement Company. Kalsu Replacement Company notifies Soldier and Command which Newcomers' Orientation at the Family Resource Center (FRC) they are required to attend.
