available to active duty military members, retirees, and their family members. Authorized patrons can bring their pets for: vaccinations, sick call, check-ups, medications, and micro-chipping. Dangerous breeds as defined as:

(Full or mixed breed) Pit Bulls, American Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Rottweiler, Chows, and Wolf Hybrids will also undergo an aggression test before going up for adoption to the public.

New pet owner's have a trial period of five complete days from the date of adoption, including weekends to relinquish animal back into stray facility, if the animal is not adjusting to the new home environment. We do not give money back/refunds, but new pet owner's are allowed to pick another animal from stray facility.
