

All Soldiers are required to in-process through Kalsu Replacement Company upon arriving Fort Campbell. Soldiers are required to attend a Newcomer's Orientation before leaving Kalsu Replacement Company to their assigned unit. If a Soldier is assigned to his/her unit and has not attended a newcomer's orientation, Kalsu Replacement Company notifies Soldier and Command which Newcomer's Orientation at the Family Resource Center (FRC) they are required to attend. Soldiers are required to arrive and be seated by 9:15am for mandatory morning briefs. Soldiers with \*Family Members attending newcomer's orientation will join them at 10:30am for remaining briefs. Single Soldiers will remain together for briefs, sponsored lunch and agency fair.
