Investment Scams

United World Exchange

- Iraqi Dinar sales
- 184 complaints of non-delivery in 1 year
- Illinois Attorney General filed suit in June 2007
- BBB rating Unsat





Ponzi Schemes

- Capital Consortium Group/3 Hebrew Boys
 - Unregistered securities dealers
 - Marketed to churches and military
 - Secrecy non-disclosure form
 - Promises \$2,625 to become \$100K in 16 months!
 - Indicted 9/11/07 by South Carolina grand jury



Rip-offs on the Web

The Military Company

- Military ribbon sets
- 150+ complaints of non-delivery in 1 year
- Postal Inspection Svc investigating
- BBB rating Unsat





Pyramid Schemes

Wealth Pools International

- "Multi-level Marketing Plan" or "Matrix Plan" selling language learning systems
- Sellers must buy each system @ \$200, make
 \$10 per sale unless they recruit more sellers
- Complaints in Florida and Fort Buchanan, Puerto Rico area
- BBB rating Unsatisfactory



Military Charity Scams

- ABC News Report on 11/9/07 that donations are not reaching wounded vets
- Reminder BBB has reports on 1,200 national charities and 5K local charities
- Look it up before you give!





What Is BBB Military Line Doing About Scams?


