Military OneSource now offers expanded services for military spouses seeking help with Career Advancement Account (CAA) questions and other career-related matters!

### **CAA Eligibility:**

The CAA initiative targets military spouses with a GED, high-school diploma, or some post-secondary education, and who are married to active-duty service members at targeted demonstration sites. Military spouses in need of renewing credentials (for example, nursing and teaching certificates) upon relocating are also eligible.

### **How Military OneSource Can Help You:**

- \* Spouses can call Military OneSource for specific information, resources and referrals
- \* A consultant will share information about education, careers and the CAA program

### **Callers May Receive:**

- \* Detailed information on the CAA initiative
- \* Research support
- \* Referrals to their Education Service Officer or Family Center Spouse Employment Program Manager
- \* Help understanding the CAA application process

### **Additional Career Support:**

- \* Education and career goal identification and evaluation
- \* Aptitude test planning
- \* Identification of portable career fields
- \* Research on projected salaries/compensation for various careers
- \* Educational resources and associated costs
- \* Career Credentialing and Licensing Information (including state requirements)
- \* Specialized training or education requirements for various careers
