



- State QRS is fully developed with tiers or levels compatible with DoD standards.
- State has a QRS as a permanent statewide program; evaluating compatibility with DoD standards
- △ State has a QRS as pilot programs in select counties; evaluating compatibility with DoD standards
- State in planning process of developing a QRS; has not implemented any pilot programs
- State has not begun the planning process of developing a QRS

NOTE: An evaluation of **all** the tiers or levels in the DC, IN, MT and NH has not been completed. These four States currently meet DoD standards only in the highest tier or level of their QRS because they *require* accreditation by any one of the following national accrediting bodies: NAEYC, NAFCC, NAA, COA, NAC, and NECPA.
