

Preparing for your success as a military sponsor is a rewarding undertaking. The Department of Defense online eSponsorship Application & Training course is now more inclusive of the many resources and scenarios you may face as a sponsor. It takes the form of a game that uses real-life situations to test your experience as you gear up to guide single service members or families arriving at their new duty station. Here are answers to FAQs about the course. The more you know, the more you can help newcomers have a strong, successful start and be mission ready.

What does the eSAT course do for sponsors?

The course gives military sponsors the tools to guide single service members or families as they arrive and settle into a new duty station. It supplements your service-specific training and requirements for sponsorship, so be sure to check for those guidelines.

What are the features of the course?

The training takes place in a game that teaches through a series of challenges that unlock five military coins. Once you have all five coins, you win! You will need to score 85% or higher on questions to complete each challenge or "mission."

Is there a completion certificate for this course?

Yes. Once you complete all five missions, you can download a certificate of completion to print or save to your computer. Go to your My Training, find Completed Courses and click Get Certificate. Your completion information will also go to your unit or command, if specified in your user profile. Otherwise, provide your certificate to your representative.

Must experienced sponsors take the entire course?

This course offers experienced sponsors an opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge and earn their certificate at the very beginning of the course. With a score of 85% correct, users will earn their coins and can opt out of completeing the entire course.

How can sponsors access the course?

Access the <u>eSAT course</u> 24/7 through MilLife Learning. Log in to an existing account or create one using a Common Access Card.
