

Child Care in Your Home Fee Assistance Pilot Program

The Child Care in Your Home pilot program provides fee assistance to service members who utilize in-home child care providers and covers full-time care for a minimum of 30 hours to a maximum of 60 hours of child care weekly. To support military families with nontraditional work schedules, care is not limited to Monday through Friday or time of day. Fee assistance only covers a portion of the cost of in-home child care. The War Department continues to add program enhancements and expand to additional regions to better meet the child care needs of military families.

Where is the Child Care in Your Home program available?

The pilot program is currently available to eligible service members and families in the following 12 regions. **Spaces are limited in each of these locations:**

- Alaska
- Colorado Springs, Colo.
- Fayetteville, N.C.
- Fort Walton Beach, Fla.
- Hawaii
- Jacksonville/Mayport, Fla.
- Las Vegas
- National Capital Region
- Norfolk, Va.
- San Antonio
- San Diego
- Seattle/Tacoma, Wash.

Who is eligible to participate?

Eligible military families in the designated regions include:

- Single or dual active-duty members
- Single or dual Guard or reserve members on active duty
- Active-duty members with a full-time working spouse
- Reserve component personnel on active duty with a full-time working spouse
- Active-duty members with a spouse enrolled in a postsecondary institution on a full-time basis
- Reserve component personnel on active duty with a spouse enrolled in a postsecondary institution on a full-time basis
