The Problematic Sexual Behavior in Children and Youth (PSB-CY) Non-Clinical Referral Tool (NCRT) is intended to assist DoDEA (Department of Defense Education Activity) and CD/YP (Child Development & Youth Program) in determining if a referral or consult to the Family Advocacy Program (FAP) is warranted based on the sexual behavior(s) exhibited by the child(ren) or youth. This tool also assists FAP personnel in establishing if a referred incident warrants engagement of the MDT (Multi-Disciplinary Team).
