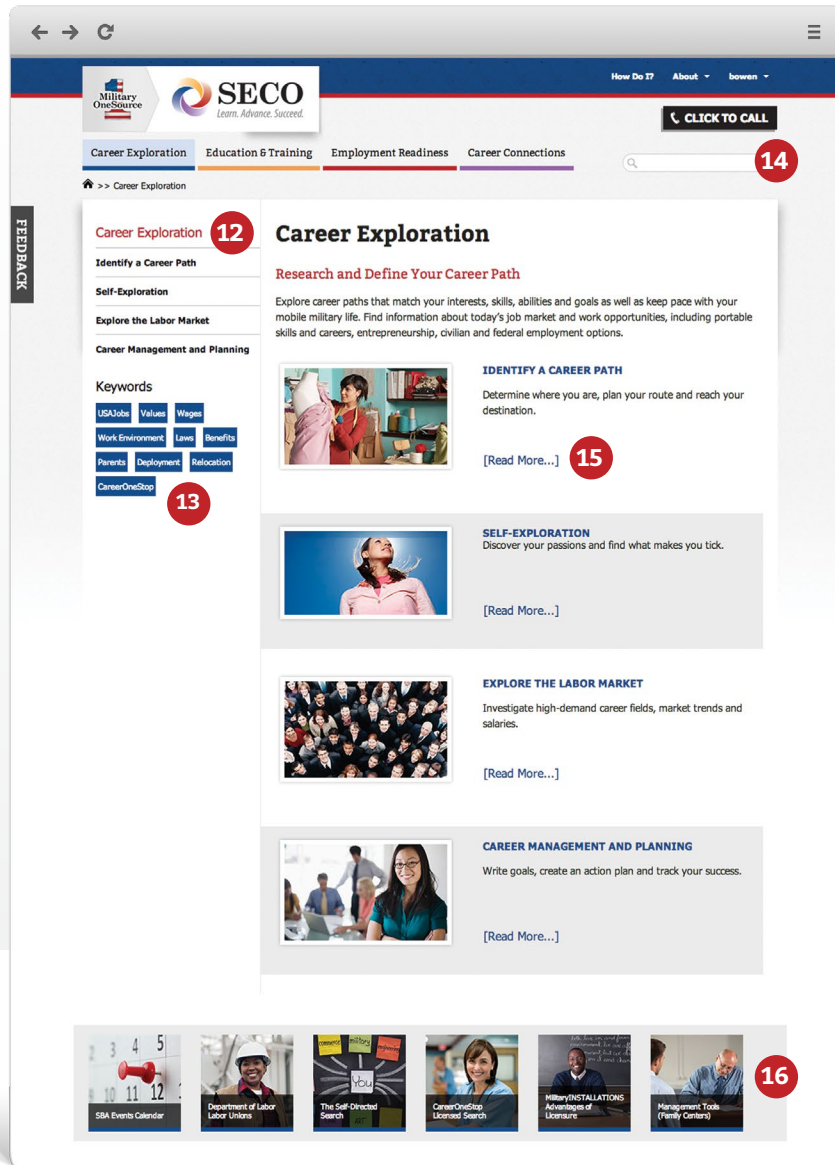
➔ Develop a personalized profile
