


## Military Pay Perks

# Key Financial Benefits for Service Members

As a service member, you may receive allowances – or extra money – beyond basic pay to offset various expenses connected to military service. These allowances address specific needs such as food and housing, and most are nontaxable.

- **Basic Allowance for Housing, or BAH:** Offsets the cost of housing. The amount is reviewed annually and is based on pay grade, geographic duty location and dependents.
  - **Basic Allowance for Subsistence, or BAS:** Offsets the cost of food for service members but not the cost of meals for family members. It is adjusted annually based on food prices.
  - **Basic Needs Allowance, or BNA:** Provides monthly financial support for service members with dependents whose gross household income is below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines for their location and household size. BNA is considered taxable income.
  - **Clothing Allowance:** Helps cover uniform costs, with amounts determined by branch based on service length, maintenance needs or special situations.
  - **Dislocation Allowance, or DLA:** Partially reimburses moving expenses due to PCS or other government-required relocations.
  - **Family Separation Allowance, or FSA:** Offers additional pay for service members living away from family at their duty station, compensating for extra expenses.
  - **Family Supplemental Subsistence Allowance, or FSSA:** Provides a monthly stipend to eligible service members serving abroad with large families and qualifying income.
  - **Cost of Living Allowance, or COLA:** A taxable, supplemental allowance designed to help offset expenses for service members assigned to expensive CONUS areas.
  - **Overseas Cost of Living Allowance, or OCOLA:** Offsets higher overseas prices of non-housing goods and services. OCOLA is nontaxable and varies based on location, pay grade, years of service, exchange rate and number of dependents.
