School liaisons can assist with transition support including transfer of credits and youth sponsorship referrals, college readiness such as test preparation and scholarships, and parent workshops covering smooth transitions and college and career preparation. They can also connect you to the Exceptional Family Member Program and your school's special education department, as well as help you navigate your new school district's special education program.
