



## How To Search USAJOBS.gov for Defense Department Child and Youth Career Opportunities

Follow these simple steps to search online for Defense Department child and youth career opportunities.

### 1 Open USAJOBS.gov

Use your web browser to open the [USAJOBS.gov](https://www.usajobs.gov) website.

### 2 Enter "Keywords"

In the box at the top of the page titled "Keywords," type "Child and Youth."

You can also search for specific service branch opportunities by typing "Child and Youth Army," "Child and Youth Marine Corps," "Child and Youth Navy" or "Child and Youth Air Force."

### 3 Enter "Location"

To view all child and youth job openings worldwide, leave the "Location" box empty and click the "Search" button on the right.

To view positions at a specific location, type a city, state, zip code or country in the "Location" box and then click the "Search" button.

### 4 View positions

Available positions will be listed on the left side of the page. Click on the position title for more information.

### 5 Review job details

Information about the position is listed on the left side of the page, starting with Overview. Scroll down to review job Location, Duties, Requirements, Required Documents, Benefits and How to Apply information.

### 6 Apply

Click on the blue "Apply" button on the top right side of the page. Follow the steps to either create a USAJOBS account or log in to your existing account.
