




Starting with the Website






Non-medical Counseling

Confidential non-medical counseling:

- For service members and military families
- Private, at no cost
- Short-term, up to 12 sessions
- Connects service members or immediate family members – to counseling from licensed mental health clinicians
- Helps with issues such as:
 - Improving relationships at home and work
 - Stress management
 - Marital and communication issues
 - Adjustment and deployment difficulties
 - Parenting skills
 - Grief or loss





In-Person Support at Your Request

Military OneSource state consultants come in person to explain the benefits, services and resources available to the military community

 - Military leaders from every branch
 - Military service providers
 - Civilian and community organizations that serve military populations
