



Shipping your POV

Quick Guide to POV Preparation

Before you turn in your vehicle for Processing, by performing the following simple tasks this will avoid unnecessary time consuming delays and potential rejection of your vehicle and in particular will avoid problems with **US Customs** or **US Dept. of Agriculture** clearance procedures.

1. Remove all Personal Items from the POV Interior & Trunk
2. Remove all TRASH/DIRT from the POV interior & Trunk

Be thorough - Perform the following Checks

- CHECK UNDERSEATS FOR LOOSE ITEMS AND TRASH
- CHECK IN BETWEEN SEATS FOR LOOSE ITEMS AND TRASH
- CHECK SEAT POCKETS FOR LOOSE ITEMS AND TRASH
- CHECK DOOR POCKETS FOR LOOSE ITEMS AND TRASH
- CHECK ISLAND STORAGE COMPARTMENTS FOR LOOSE ITEMS AND TRASH
- CHECK GLOVE COMPARTMENT FOR LOOSE ITEMS AND TRASH
- CHECK TRUNK /UNDER HOOD AND SPARE TIRE AREA FOR LOOSE ITEMS AND TRASH
- VACUUM OUT ALL DIRT, SAND, LEAVES AND INSECTS FROM INTERIOR AND UNDER HOOD AND TRUNK AREAS.
- REMOVE ALL AIR FRESHENERS
- REMOVE ALL HANGING OBJECTS FROM MIRRORS AND WINDOWS
- REMOVE ALL LIQUID AND GAS ITEMS THAT ARE FLAMABLE AND/OR COMBUSTIBLE (E.G. FLARES, WAXES, PROTECTANTS, OILS CLEANERS)
- REMOVE OR RETRACT ANY ANTENNAS
- REMOVE SEAT AND STEERING WHEEL COVERS – UNLESS PROFESSIONALLY INSTALLED
- REMOVE BATTERIES FROM FLASHLIGHTS AND TOOLS
- UNDERCARRIAGE IS CLEANED TO MEET USDA REQUIREMENT.

FINALLY

- ENSURE VEHICLE IS SPOTLESSLY CLEAN - INSIDE & OUTSIDE
- GAS IS TO ¼ TANK (ONE FOURTH OF A TANK OR LESS) GAS CANNOT BE SYPHONED AT THE VPC.
